## Arlington Assets for Working Families

### You may be eligible for a federal income tax credit.

Every year, taxpayers with middle and low incomes miss out on thousands of dollars of credit that could put money back in their pockets.

The Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) is a refundable federal income tax credit for working individuals and families.

#### How much can workers earn and qualify for EITC?

Number of Children	Income less than	Credit up to
1 child	\$35,463	\$3,043
2 children	\$40,295	\$5,028
3 or more children	\$43,279	\$5,657
No children	\$13,440	\$457



The Arlington Assets for Working Families is a partnership of the Arlington Human Service Planners, the Community Tax Centers, AARP, and the City of Arlington, working to provide free tax assistance to low and middle income families that may be eligible for the tax credit. In addition, AARP offers special attention to taxpayers age 60 and older.

- ★ The average refund amount for families is \$2,280.
- ★ Income limits for married workers who file their taxes jointly are \$2,000 higher than amounts shown above.
- ★ Investment income cannot exceed \$2,900.
