Amendment to the 2008-2009 Action Plan

The City of Arlington is amending the 2008 Action Plan to adjust the budget for the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP). The amendment provides for an increase in funding for direct financial assistance activities to \$914,042 and a decrease in funding for relocation/stabilization services to \$285,958. The remaining elements of the HPRP budget will not change. The table below represents a comparison of the amended and the original HPRP budgets.

The City of Arlington will follow its public participation procedures for a Substantial Amendment as outlined in the 2005-2010 Consolidated Plan. This process includes a 30-day public comment period from August 21 to September 21, 2009, City Council review on September 1, 2009, and a public hearing on September 10, 2009.
