GAS DRILLING AND PRODUCTION APPLICATION CHECKLIST (per Ordinance No. 07-074):

Operator must submit eight (8) complete copies of the following at the time of permit application. Label Exhibits.

- Exhibit A:** Proof of approved zoning.
- Exhibit B:** Map showing proposed transportation route and road for equipment, supplies, chemicals, or waste products used or produced by the gas operation. The map shall include both a visual and text description of all roads that will be used for ingress and egress access to the site and shall include a distance traveled measurement in miles. The map shall also show the location of any areas to be used for truck staging or storage related to the drill site.
- Exhibit C:** Location and description of all buildings within six hundred (600) feet of the well.
- Exhibit D:** A site plan of the proposed drill site and operation site showing the location of all improvements and equipment, including the location of the proposed well(s) and other facilities, including, but not limited to, fire hydrants proposed to supply water to the site, tanks, pipelines, lights, floodways, compressors, separators and storage sheds.
- Exhibit E:** A detailed site plan that includes specific details to the projected location of the major components of the drilling site, approved landscape plan, impacted vegetation, creeks and other topographic features, adjacent buildings and other structures and the measured distance from the well site to these buildings and structures, temporary and permanent fencing and landscaping. Site plan shall include distance measurements to nearest protected uses; specifically residences, schools, and parks.
- Exhibit F:** A description of public utilities required during drilling and operation.
- Exhibit G:** A site plan showing fire protection for the site, which shall include public/private hydrants or proposed alternate means of fire protection.
- Exhibit H:** A detailed site plan of the proposed drill site to include the location of the proposed water supply for the site, a description of the water source to be used during drilling, an estimate of the total volume of water needed, and the approximate dates the water supply will be needed at the site. If the water source will be the City of Arlington municipal water supply, provide the maximum withdrawal rate in gallons per minute from each point of withdrawal. **A copy of the approved site plan shall accompany any request for temporary construction meter.**
- Exhibit I:** A copy of the approved Railroad Commission permit to drill with attachments (W-1 and P-12) and survey plats applicable to the drill and operation sites.
- Exhibit J:** A copy of any Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan required by the Environmental Protection Agency. A copy of the notice of intent shall be submitted to the City of Arlington, Department of Public Works and Transportation, and Environmental Services Department three (3) days prior to the commencement of any onsite activity.
- Exhibit K:** An accurate legal description of the lease property to be used for the gas operation, the parcel and the production unit, and name of the geologic formation as used by the Railroad Commission. Property recorded by plat should reference subdivision, block and lot numbers.
- Exhibit L:** A copy of the determination by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality of the depth of useable quality ground water.
- Exhibit M:** The insurance and security documents required under this Chapter.
- Exhibit N:** An Emergency Action Response Plan establishing written procedures to minimize any hazard resulting from drilling, completion or producing of gas wells. Said plan shall use existing guidelines established by the Railroad Commission, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, Department of Transportation, and/or the Environmental Protection Agency. The Plan should include drive-to-maps from public rights-of-way to drill site.
- Exhibit O:** A Hazardous Materials Management Plan shall be submitted and be on file with the Fire Department and the Inspector.
- Exhibit P:** A copy of the pre-drilling ambient noise level report.

Also required during permit process:

- Exhibit Q:** Copy of notice publication in newspaper for ten (10) consecutive days. (Must be published at least fifteen (15) days and no more than twenty (20) days prior to the date of the public hearing before City Council.)
- Exhibit R:** Photo of requested onsite sign at proposed well site. (Must be erected at least twenty (20) days prior to the date of the public hearing before City Council.)
