#### III. Demolition Permit Applications

#### 1. 2026 Skylark Drive

Ms. Stubblefield gave a presentation regarding the home built in 1955 on 0.2060-acres. The property is not listed on the Historic Resources Survey. Vice-Chair Reber had performed a site visit and the structure was un-occupied and in bad condition.

Chair Rumans opened the Public Hearing for this item. Dave Spurlock, owner of the property, mentioned that there had been issues with vagrants in the home along with drug deals and traffic. The property was contaminated with chemicals used in drug manufacturing and raw sewage. He said that he planned to rebuild a nice home to fit in with the existing neighborhood and thanked the Commission for their time.

Vice-Chair Reber moved to approve the first option and release the historic stay on the property located at 2026 Skylark Drive. Seconded by Commissioner Penson, the motion was approved unanimously.
