- I. **Call to Order** – Chair Rumans called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance**
- III. **Announcements**
Ms. Stubblefield announced that Geoff Scheid and Suzanne Sweek were both leaving the Commission and thanked them for their volunteer service.
- IV. **Approval of Minutes** – May 13, 2021
Commissioner Sweek moved to approve the May 13, 2021, minutes. Seconded by Commissioner Patterson, the minutes were approved unanimously.
- V. **Presentation: Development of Online “Story Maps”**
Mr. Cisneros presented “Story Maps” using online aerial maps along with images and text, displaying the work he had done on The Hill and Top O’Hill Terrace as examples of the interactive maps currently on the webpage. A Bankhead Highway story map is in progress. It was suggested that a story map of the Arlington Cemetery be included next, with identification and historic information about some of the people buried there. It was also suggested that older neighborhoods be featured in story maps using pictures and information provided by residents. Commissioners were encouraged to discuss ideas AND assist with research for additional Story Maps that are created by City staff.
- VI. **Work Plan Items**
 1. **Discussion: THC Training Grant Debrief**
Ms. Stubblefield announced that the CAMP Training was available to view online for anyone who may have missed it until August 2021.

The last Historic Resources Survey was last done in 2007 and would likely not be updated in 2027. It was suggested that a survey of Webb be done in the near future

before development took over the community completely. A Landmark Preservation Overlay could also be created to preserve individual structures.

Ms. Stubblefield noted that a new Historic Resources Survey could be combined with the Preservation Plan as a single project document.

It was also suggested that Commissioners meet with the Council person who appointed them once or twice a year to present a single-page data sheet document highlighting recent LPC projects, possibly categorizing structures by time periods.
