- Arlington's Open Data Program
- Launched January 2017
- Helped earn What Works Cities Gold Certification

OPEN ARLINGTON



- Serves as a central clearinghouse for City data
- Developed in response to the City Council's Put Technology to Work Council Priority
- Provides public with access to the data City employees develop and use every day
- Goal is to increase transparency between the City and the public

OPEN ARLINGTON



- Combines Arlington's numerous GIS and data analytics programs:
 - Open Data Portal
 - Interactive web maps
 - Static reports and infographics
- Designed for wide range of audiences, from researchers and data scientists to casual users

OPEN DATA PORTAL




- 47 downloadable datasets and growing

OPEN DATA PORTAL




- Web apps provide residents with mobileready interfaces


