




Temporary Pavement Repair

Street Reclamation Process

pulverize and mix existing asphalt surface and base with lime and cement, and stabilize to a new 8-inch base



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pulverize and mix existing asphalt surface and base with lime and cement, and stabilize to a new 8-inch base

install 8-inch Hot Mix Asphaltic Concrete (HMAC) for the entire width of the street

Construction Schedule

Construction is scheduled to begin November 6th, 2023

The anticipated construction time is 420 calendar days

Questions

- How long will the water be shut off?
 - Scheduled water shut off typically takes 4-6 hours. Affected properties will be notified 48 hours prior to the shut off by the contractor using door hangers.
- Will there be any disruption to the sewer service? No sewer disruption is anticipated.
- Will the contractor restore the grass affected by construction?

Grass areas affected by construction will be restored to match existing condition and will require watering by the property owner after being established. The city inspector will videotape the project area to document existing conditions before the start of construction.

Is the driveway still accessible?

Parking in your driveway may be restricted during the installation of pipes and street reclamation process. This will be coordinated with you by the contractor.

How will this affect UTA traffic?

UTA Parking lots will have at least one access point as to not interfere with student parking. Work on UTA parking lot fed roads (Doug Russell Road, Grand Avenue, and West Street) is scheduled to begin during Summer months.

• Will the contractor work on weekends?

May be working on Saturdays, but not on Sundays.
