## **Fan Participation Tips**

- With your patience, we'll achieve greatness: We'll try to keep things moving as fast as we can, but in order to capture a dramatic image for our Opening Day JumboTron video, we'll need you to stay in place once you get into your designated letter.
- Therefore we highly recommend that you make a point of visiting the restroom or taking care of any other personal business prior to your arrival. **If you have difficulty standing for more than one hour at a time**, or if you have a little Ranger fan in tow, you may want to consider cheering us on from the sidelines rather than joining the spell out.
- **Picture perfect**: Please avoid white or lighter-colored attire in favor of dark-colored clothing. Even better, come decked out in your favorite **Rangers red and blue gear**!
- **Parking's easy**: Rangers fans will have access to free parking in <u>Parking Lots B, C and J</u>, located near Stadium Drive and Randol Mill.
- We've got you covered: There's no need to bring your own glow stick. (However, glow sticks are only available on a first-come, first-served basis, so get here as close to the 6 p.m. registration).
- Shake it, but safely: We may ask you to move your glow stick around a bit for maximum illumination during our spell-out, but GLO CAREFULLY. Swinging or twirled glow sticks can hurt if they land on someone's face or eyes. We want you to have fun and be safe!

- Travel light: There won't be seating or storage facilities on site, so we suggest that you keep your purses, backpacks and wallets secured and out of sight in your locked vehicle. Please only bring a lawn chair if you plan on cheering us on from the sidelines, not if you plan on joining the spell out. (And please know that the event producers assume no responsibility for your personal property.)
- You **may want to bring bottled water with you**; or even better, make sure you hydrate before the event. Please show respect to the Rangers' home field by disposing of your trash properly.
- **Post fan parties:** There won't be food or beverage service on site, but we encourage everyone to visit nearby <u>Birraporetti's</u> or <u>Alley Cats</u> for post-fan parties.
