Neighborhood Outreach



- The City does not have a comprehensive list of neighborhoods, HOAs, or neighborhood contacts
- If the City does have recent contact information for neighborhoods in or adjacent to a proposed project site, Neighborhood Engagement Team will coordinate connection to those neighborhood contacts
- If no neighborhood contacts are available, Neighborhood Engagement Team can notify neighborhoods in surrounding neighborhoods through use of Nextdoor

Neighborhood Outreach



- If a proposed project has a project website, development details, or public meeting to share with community, send the following information to neighborhoods@arlingtontx.gov:
 - Images/documents you wish to share
 - 2-3 sentences about the project/meeting
 - Contact information for residents to call/email
- Neighborhood Engagement Team will share on Nextdoor and coordinate any comments and final metrics to project team upon request
- Email is most efficient method to receive information about neighborhoods and neighborhood contacts
