# **South Substation Renamed for Former APD Police Chief Theron Bowman**

On Monday, March 28, the City of Arlington renamed the South police substation for former police chief, Dr. Theron L. Bowman. Dr. Bowman, a Fort Worth native, attended the University of Texas at Arlington where he obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Biology, a Master's Degree in Public Administration, and a Ph.D. in Urban and Public Administration. He began his law enforcement career with the Arlington Police Department in 1983 and became Chief of Police in 1999. He remained Police Chief until 2013 and later served as a Deputy City Manager for the City of Arlington before his retirement.



## ATM Burglar Arrested by Patrol

East Patrol Officer Caleb Elliott was dispatched to a burglary in progress of a bank ATM. A security company was watching a live feed of the offense and provided real-time descriptions as the incident unfolded. Caleb arrived and found fresh evidence of the burglary, but the suspect had already left the scene.

Officers Jared Edwards and James Mitchell also responded. Jared spotted a vehicle leaving the area and noticed the driver matched the suspect description given by the security company. A check of the license plate showed there was a possible warrant hit on the vehicle. Jared and James conducted a traffic stop and contacted the driver. The driver was found to be wearing the same slething described by the acquirity company and was in a



clothing described by the security company and was in possession of a similar duffel bag. The officers then placed the suspect under arrest for the attempted theft of property after their investigation led them to believe they had probable cause that the detained suspect committed the offense.
