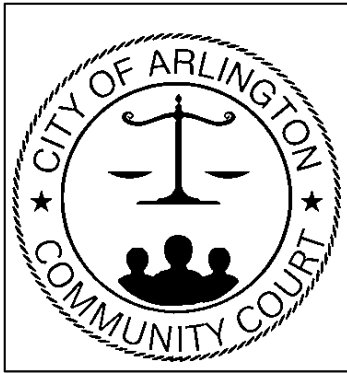


# CAN'T PAY YOUR CITATION?

**If you meet the federal poverty guidelines, identify as unsheltered, have served in or are currently serving the armed forces, or reside in the following zip codes: 76010, 76112, 76120, 76011, or 76119, you may be eligible to resolve your citation(s) through hours, instead of payments.**

**Alternatives to payment include options such as volunteer work, counseling, workforce training, GED courses, ESL classes, etc.**

## DISCLAIMER:

In order to proceed with Community Court, you are required to enter a plea of no contest and your citation(s) must be eligible for deferred disposition. If you are currently being charged with an offense related to the use of a firearm or weapon, the use of force, or there is an allegation of death or serious bodily injury, you will be deemed ineligible.
